QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Why do we need to build?

God has been blessing and we have run out of space. Even with two worship services on Sunday mornings, we are usually close to (or over) capacity. PCC's leadership anticipated this wonderful "problem" many years ago and began making plans for expansion. The Multi-Purpose facility is already well underway with infrastructure in place and a steel building shell erected. One of the goals of Project Oasis is the completion of this construction phase. As soon as we occupy this new building, we anticipate immediate and significant additional growth in our congregation. More people reached = greater impact for the Kingdom of God!

How much will it cost?

Based on estimates with our construction manager and various suppliers, we anticipate that finishing this phase of our expansion will cost somewhere in the range of one- to 1.25 million dollars.

How will we use this building?

As the name implies, this facility will have multiple uses. It will become our primary worship center; we will use it for large group activities (like Awana® or special Academy and Preschool programs); and the classrooms will be larger for our regular Sunday School and Bible Studies, and the like.

How soon can we be in the building?

With the progress made thus far, when the funds are made available continued construction can proceed relatively unhindered. It is conceivable you can be in your new facility before year's end. Our goal is to occupy by Easter of 2010.

HOW CAN YOU BE INVOLVED?

1. Pray

The Scriptures teach that, ultimately, giving financially to God's work is an act of worship. So let's begin by praying that God would overwhelm us with a spirit of gratitude for all that He has done for us, both as individuals and as a church. Let's pray that He would motivate and enable us to give generously to this project and that He would amaze us with His abundant provision through this campaign.

2. Plan

Take some time to carefully consider what you could commit to this campaign over the next 36 months (over and above your normal giving to the church). The chart on back demonstrates that even a small increase in weekly giving goes a long way over a three-year period. You might consider giving from savings, tax refunds, or even a garage sale. Perhaps you could reduce expenses or defer a major purchase as a sacrifice to God. Do some creative brainstorming as a family and you'll be surprised at what you can come up with!

3. Commit

After careful prayer and planning, we will provide a commitment card for you to indicate the amount that God is leading you to give over the next 36 months. On Sunday, March 29, we will have a special Worship Service to collect our commitments and to celebrate this momentous opportunity in the life of our church.

Then, on Palm Sunday, April 5, we will take up a "First Fruits" offering to kick off our three-year commitments.
